



Further to your information request FOI/EIR 25/26-020, please find your question and our response below.

Request:

I'm contacting you in relation to a food safety inspection report, carried out on the premises known as The Griddle Bar and Meat House, located at 7 High Street Passage, Ely, Cambridgeshire.

I'm concerned at the information published on the gov.uk site, mentioning improvements being needed in the preparation, handling, storage, cooking and reheating of food, and even more at the issues raised regarding checking that food is safe to serve.

Would I please be able to obtain a copy of the food safety inspector's report into the premises, so that I can gain an understanding of what triggered those ratings, and thus help me make an informed choice as to whether to visit, please?
