- How many appeals have been lodged against the penalty charge notices in 2022, 2023, 2024 & 2025?
- How many appeals saw a successful outcome for the claimant in 2022, 2023, 2024 & 2025?
- Please can you share what the money from penalty charge notices was used for in 2022, 2023, 2024 & 2025?
- Do you use a private parking company to issue penalty charge notices, if yes which company do you use?
